The children can self-analyse, their achievements.

Step 1; each child should have a card with Main values and sub values.

Step2; At the end of the class, the child can be encouraged to think about the actions carried out during the class, and tick the values he/she achieved that day.

Example; 1) during the class, whether helped another child, helped the teacher to set the class.

2) Handle the material carefully or arranged the things in order.

3) Could mark a green dot under the sub value to which the action related.

4) If the child is not confident enough can mark in another colour like blue.
