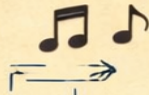

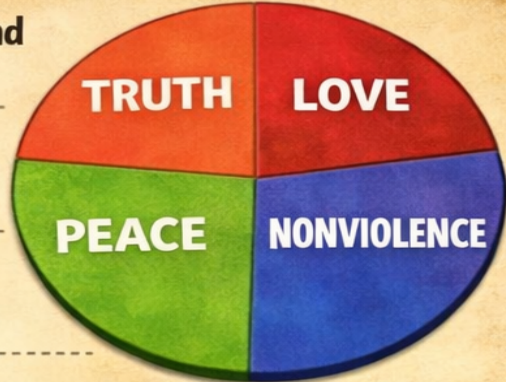
Outdoor Value Game

Value Oriented Activity 20C

Overcome with sub values.

The children have played lot of indoor games. Now they need to get out and play values.

Here is the chance to get out and move around. This game is similar to the musical circle, where walking round the circle, when music stops enter in to the one of the four quarters.

Here in the four quarters are the main values. Then the chit will be drawn to find which one will be out. Here there is a different they don't need to go out, if they say a related sub value. Ex If the children in the Truth have to leave; each one has to say one of the sub values related to Truth, to continue the game.

To make the game more challenging, can use sense, five elements, or the first two or three who give quick answer can remain and continue the game.

The teachers can go according to the children's need and interest.
